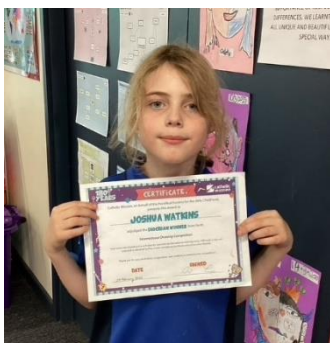


Expressions of Interest – 3-Year-Old Pre-Kindergarten Program for 2024
