Our P&F have been busy with a variety of events and for next Friday 9 June they have organised Hot Chocolate and Fruit Toast for recess. With the change to the running of the P&F all the money raised must be allocated to specific projects. This year the P&F have donated \$350 for each of our classroom teachers, art and science programs for educational resources.

The P&F are also considering the allocation of funds raised to go towards the creation of a basketball/netball half-court on the oval near the sports shed. The school is in the process of obtaining quotes to be presented at the next P&F meeting at which time a decision will be made by the P&F of the amount they will contribute towards this project.
