## From the Principal

Welcome back to all families for Term 2. I hope everyone enjoyed a relaxing holiday break.

A special welcome to Ava who has recently joined the Year One class. Also welcome to Peyton and Maali who started in Pre Kindy on Monday. I hope you and your families enjoy being part of the Sacred Heart School community and make many happy memories.

The term for staff commenced with a professional development day on Monday. The focus of the day was on the Holy Spirit and the part the Spirit plays in our lives. Allan Gotti from CEWA led the day which revolved around looking at the Bible and challenging staff to look at their understanding and knowledge of the Spirit. With the feast of Pentecost and the Sacrament of Confirmation this term it was a very important focus for all at the school. Staff will be using the knowledge gained to further enhance lessons for the students.

We had our Opening School Mass today and thank you to O'Connor teachers and students for preparing the Mass and being involved in it.
