The online ordering system will be available from Monday 22 May to Friday 14 July 2023. Orders can be pre-purchased securely online. Payments by cash and cheque through the usual envelope method is available if you do not wish to pay online. Envelopes are available from the school office if required.

Speaking of school photos leads one naturally into speaking about our school uniform. At last week's assembly some students were singled out for their correct wearing of the school uniform. Now that the mornings (and soon the whole day)

are particularly chilly, you are reminded that all students in Year 1 – 6 must wear the school jumper with the uniform. Two varieties are available – the warmer wool version and the non-itchy cotton/synthetic variety. There is no need to wear the sports tracksuit top or under garment with long sleeves. Please consult with the office about the availability of these essential items.

The other area of concern is incorrect footwear. The everyday school uniform consists of **black leather shoes** (not sneakers). The sports uniform requires preferably white sneakers. These I know are not always readily available, so sneakers in other light colours are acceptable but the “over-the-top” fluoro-coloured sneakers are NOT acceptable.

Please address these matters where required or reminders will be sent home from your child’s teacher.
